SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABILITY PERIOD

This scholarship is available for 2026 and 2027 intakes.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

A reduction of **25% off** the total course tuition fee.

- **4 subject semester package** (60 La Trobe credits): AUD 11,800² – 25% = Total tuition AUD 8,850.
- **3 subject semester package** (45 La Trobe credits): AUD 8,850² – 25% = Total tuition AUD 6,638.

Application requirements: A 200-word statement of motivation that demonstrates your genuine interest in learning more about Australia's First Nations people and culture.

2. STUDY ABROAD: SOCIAL JUSTICE AND INTERNATIONALISATION

La Trobe is dedicated to social justice and empowering underrepresented students—First Nations, those with disabilities, or from low socio-economic backgrounds—to embark on life-changing study abroad experiences.

Application requirements: Provide a 200-word statement of motivation that outlines your interest in social justice, the challenges that might prevent you from studying abroad, and how this scholarship will help you overcome them to study in Australia.

SEMESTER DATES

- **Semester 1:** Mid-February to end of June
- **Semester 2:** End of July to mid-November

REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be enrolled at a university outside of Australia.
2. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
3. Applicants must write a statement based on **one** of the above two streams and meet the application requirements.
