<b>Purpose</b> 	<p>Hockey Victoria aims to represent, promote and foster the interests of all hockey participants in Victoria, so that we achieve long-term sustainability, growth and success. In order to achieve this goal, Hockey Victoria aims to provide clear direction for their clubs and associations, deliver innovative opportunities for players of all skills levels to participate, and inspire players to reach their potential.</p>
<b>Method</b> 	<p>The first stage of the research was conducted between December 2017 and January 2018, which was exclusively quantitative. Specifically, more than 950 Hockey Victoria players, parents or former players completed a survey. The second stage of the research sought to explore themes revealed through the first stage of the research, the structure of Hockey Victoria competitions and the ways in which Hockey Victoria competitions could be structured in order to improve the experience of Hockey Victoria members and stakeholders.</p>
<b>Application</b> 	<p>Key findings were presented across three main themes: 1. Overall concerns of players; 2. The steps Hockey Victoria could take in implementing changes to the structure of Victorian hockey competitions; and 3. Further opportunities for growth.</p>
