



Overseas Short Programs

There are a variety of overseas short programs that you can undertake in nearly every country around the world!

Overseas short programs allow you to participate in an overseas experience for 1 or 2 subject credits of your LTU degree. The type of experience varies and include internships, study tours or even clinical placements to meet your study requirements.

Virtual Programs

Online opportunities have been developed for students to participate in an academic subject with one of our partner universities, undertake a study tour or intern with an international company and earn skills that are essential in a today's remote workforce.

LTU Academic-led Programs

Academic-led programs include study tours and placement opportunities as part of an LTU subject that are arranged and advertised by our academics. These programs offer students an opportunity to enjoy a pre-organised itinerary while studying overseas in their discipline.

University Partner Programs

Short academic, language or cultural programs coordinated through LTU partner institutions, usually during summer or winter break.

Third Party Programs

Academic based programs through a third party LTU partner, who offer multi-disciplinary options in various countries worldwide.

Partners include CISAustralia, Work the World and Projects Abroad. Programs include course work, internships and clinical placements.

Internships

4 to 12 week internships in India, Indonesia, Spain, Japan, USA, UK, Canada and many more destinations. Intern in a professional setting with a tailored experience suitable for a variety of disciplines.

Clinical Placements

If your degree entails a practicum or clinical placement, you may be able to do this overseas through your College or refer to the opportunities available at La Trobe Abroad. Suitable for degrees including nursing, physiotherapy, bio-medicine, psychology and many others.

Overseas Short Programs are open to all La Trobe University students!

Overseas Short Program Funding

To help cover costs you will be eligible for one or more of the below La Trobe mobility grants or scholarships. In addition, all students are covered by La Trobe University's insurance for the duration of their program. You may also be able to apply for continued Centrelink payments and the Governments interest-free OS-HELP Loan of **up to \$8,444**.

Costs vary depending on the program, location, currency rate, accommodation, airfares, visas and living expenses.

Application Dates

Application dates vary from program to program. You should start your application 3 to 6 months before the program and have all of your application documents submitted to La Trobe Abroad at least 4 weeks before your program starts.

Virtual Programs

Partner University Online Subjects

Complete an academic subject online with LTU partners during your summer or winter break and experience university in a foreign country without leaving home.

Partners include ISEP, Ewha University in Korea, WHU Otto Beisheim School of Management in Germany, and Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore in Italy, just to name a few.

Funding is available for programs and some are fully-funded. Plus, completing a subject during your break means one less subject during semester!

Virtual Internships & Study Tours

Complete an international internship or practicum anytime throughout the year with partners that include CISaustralia and ACICIS in Indonesia.

Some of the benefits of completing a virtual internship include skills such as the ability to work remotely across time zones and cultures, as well as developing confidence in a particular professional context.

ACICIS also offer a virtual Public Health Study Tour, a two-week intensive program for public health students to gain experience in the public health sector in Indonesia.
