Overseas Short Programs

There are a variety of overseas short programs that you can undertake in nearly every country around the world!

Overseas short programs allow you to participate in an overseas experience for 1 or 2 subject credits of your LTU degree. The type of experience varies and includes internships, study tours or even clinical placements to meet your study requirements.

Study Tours lead by LTU Academics

Academic-led programs are La Trobe subjects advertised by the academics, and offer students who may not be able to undertake a full semester abroad an opportunity to study overseas in their discipline.

University Partner Programs

Short academic, language or cultural programs coordinated through La Trobe University partner institutions. Some may be available as tuition-free places.

Third Party Programs

Academic based programs through a third party La Trobe University partner, who offers multi-disciplinary options in various countries worldwide.

Partners include CISAustralia, Work the World and Projects Abroad.

Suitable for degrees in Arts, Business, Science and more.

Internships

4-8 week internships in India, Indonesia, Spain, Japan, USA, UK, Canada and many more destinations each January-February. Intern in a professional setting with a tailored experience suitable for a variety of disciplines.

Clinical Placements

If your degree entails a practicum or clinical placement, you may be able to do this overseas through your College or refer to the opportunities available at La Trobe Abroad. Suitable for degrees including nursing, physiotherapy, bio-medicine, psychology and many others.

Overseas Short Program Funding

To help cover these costs you will be eligible for one of the below a La Trobe mobility grants. In addition, all students are covered by La Trobe University's insurance for the duration of their program and you may be able to apply for continued Centrelink Payments.

Costs vary depending on the program, currency rate, accommodation, airfares, visas and living expenses.

Application Dates

Application dates vary from program to program. You should start your application 3 to 6 months before the program and have all of your application documents submitted to La Trobe Abroad at least 4 weeks before your program starts.

International Sustainability Experience (ISE)

Available across a broad range of La Trobe business and humanities degrees, the ISE elective is a 30 Credit Point environmental studies subject culminating in a two-week overseas field trip in January 2021.

The subject will explore the interconnection of place, society and the environment. Undertake a pre-trip preparation module comprising a mix of face-to-face and online learning then spend a week working on sustainability projects, helping find solutions to real-world problems while developing cultural awareness, problem solving, teamwork and communication skills.

Whatever your financial situation, from January 2021 you could be one of the La Trobe students travelling to locations across the Asia Pacific region. La Trobe covers the cost of airfares (with an open-ended return date), accommodation, food, transport, visa fees and insurance!
