



Postgraduate Overseas Programs

La Trobe University is committed to providing our students with opportunities to study overseas.

If you're a postgraduate coursework student, why not combine study with adventure and enrich your La Trobe degree by participating in a Semester Exchange or an Overseas Short Program to Asia, Latin America, Europe, North America, the UK or Scandinavia.

Semester Exchange

Semester exchange allows you to travel overseas and study subjects for your LTU degree at the same time, for either one or two semesters at one of our 120+ partnered universities.

You will exchange places with one of their students, continue to pay your LTU fees and get credits back into your LTU degree upon your return.

Eligibility

- Completed minimum (120 credit points) by the time you start the exchange program
- Minimum 65% overall grade average (some partner universities require a higher average)
- Be enrolled as a La Trobe student the semester before, during and after (both domestic and international students can apply)

Overseas Short Programs

Overseas short programs allow you to participate in an overseas experience for 1 or 2 subject credits of your La Trobe degree in as little as two weeks. The type of experience can vary from academic programs to internships to study tours or even clinical placements.

Program Funding & Costs

Costs vary depending on the host university, currency rate, accommodation, airfares, visas and living expenses. To help cover these costs you will be eligible for one or more LTU mobility grants or scholarships. In addition, all students are covered by La Trobe University's insurance for the duration of their program.

Domestic students may be able to apply for continued Centrelink payments and the Government's interest-free OS-HELP Loan of up to **\$8,444**.

While postgraduate students are eligible to apply for Semester Exchange and Overseas Short Programs, there may be restrictions: accreditation, language requirements, pre-requisites, plus international students intending to apply for post-study work rights are required to complete 240 credit points onshore in Australia. We encourage you to discuss your options with your academic course coordinator in the first instance.
