

Go to Ims.latrobe.edu.au (1) and log in (2) with your student details:




You should now be taken to your reading list, which should look something like this.




Reading lists may be **organised** by topic or week. This one is organised **by week**.



B. Access Reading Lists through your weekly reading lists in the LMS





Select the module for which you'd like to access the reading list e.g. Module 5.



C. Access Reading Lists through library home page


Go to the library home page:






D. Viewing items

To view an item, select 'view online'.




E. Availability of items




F. Useful Features
