

## **Single Degree Students**

Single degree students are encouraged to study at a partner university that has both PSY2DEV Developmental Psychology and PSY2SOC Social Psychology matched, as these subjects are pre-requisites for La Trobe third year subjects. You can then choose two elective subjects that will make up your full time study load while on exchange.

Partner universities for single degree students are located in Canada and the USA. All are listed overleaf.

However, if you are willing to extend your degree this will allow flexibility in your study plan to choose a different partner university.

## **Double Degree Students**

Double degree students have more flexibility to rearrange subjects in your study plan while still ensuring pre-requisites are met for subjects in subsequent years. You also have the option of selecting subjects from either degree to make up your full time study load while on exchange.

Partner universities for double degree students who wish to study PSY2DEV Developmental Psychology and/or PSY2SOC Social Psychology while on exchange are located in Canada, USA, Sweden, The Netherlands and the UK. All are listed overleaf.

## **Semester Exchange**

Semester exchange allows you to travel overseas and study subjects for your LTU degree at the same time, for either one or two semesters at one of our 120+ partnered universities.

You will exchange places with one of their students, continue to pay your LTU fees and get credits back into your LTU degree.
