



Semester Exchange

What is Semester Exchange?

Semester exchange allows you to travel overseas and study subjects for your LTU degree at the same time, for either one or two semesters at one of our 120+ partnered universities.

You will exchange places with one of their students, continue to pay your LTU fees and get credits back into your LTU degree upon your return.

Eligibility

- Completed minimum (120 credit points) by the time you start the exchange program
- Minimum 65% overall grade average (some partner universities require a higher average)
- Be enrolled as a La Trobe student the semester before, during and after (both domestic and international students can apply)

How to apply

- 1) Check your LTU study plan and available subjects.
- 2) Find a suitable overseas university for your degree from our list of exchange partners or through the International Student Exchange Program (ISEP). Institutions you choose must offer subjects relevant to your degree, teach in the language of your competency and be able to accommodate for any special needs you may have.
- 3) Apply online.

Program Costs

Costs vary depending on the Host University, currency rate, accommodation, airfares, visas and living expenses.

To help cover these costs you will be eligible for one or more of the below LTU mobility grants or scholarships. In addition, you may be able to apply for continued Centrelink payments and the Government's interest-free OS-HELP Loan of **up to \$8,444**.

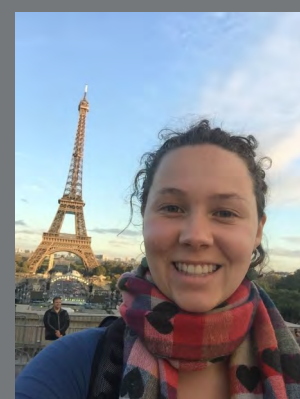
