

CITY STUDIO:

Short-term Housing Solutions





Join the global CityStudio network to investigate how we can address issues around transitional housing.

CityStudio is an immersive global program that takes students outside the classroom, working with their local Council, community and university to make places more sustainable, inclusive, liveable and joyful. In CityStudio 2023, students will work with the City of Greater Bendigo to explore ways to address issues around short-term housing which is an emerging concern for the rapidly changing demgraphics and related challenges of inadequate housing in the city.

Students will develop and test experimental projects to engage the community in thinking about ways to provide short-term housing in the city. Drawing on design thinking techniques, students will need to think deeply and creatively around a range of options including tiny houses, flatpack houses, transportable houses, modular housing, pop-up houses, etc. They will explore perspectives about short-term housing options for emergency response, essential employees, seasonal workers and temporary workforce coming for the 2026 Commonwealth Games.
