Position Summary

The purpose of this position is to support and work with the Senior Coordinator, Representative and High Performance Sport in managing programs and the administration, planning and development of La Trobe Sport representative teams.

This includes opportunities to work across University Nationals, Intersport events and franchise teams based in the La Trobe Sports Park, whilst working with the wider La Trobe Sport staff, industry contacts and student volunteers. Other ad hoc activities will also be carried out across Team La Trobe including Clubs, La Trobe Elite Athlete Program and La Trobe League (social sport).

Duties may include

1. Support the Snr Coord, Representative and High Performance Sport in the administration and development of University Nationals, Intersport and Team La Trobe events.
2. Assist in the operational delivery of the Sports Performance Hub across Elite and Community programs.
3. Assist in the operational delivery of semi-professional sport franchise teams based at the La Trobe Sports Park.
4. Assist in the recruitment, registration and team formation activities of all representative sport programs.
5. Liaise, communicate and build effective and professional relationships with both La Trobe Sport staff and external stakeholders, to support the Snr Coord, Representative and High Performance Sport in the continued growth and development of representative sport programs.
6. Effectively assist in communication channels to students including social media and emails as directed by the Snr Coord, Representative and High Performance Sport.
7. Assist the Snr Coord, Representative and High Performance Sport in the planning and execution of events associated with representative sport on and off campus.
8. Oversee all La Trobe Uni Nationals registrations via Revolutionise and UniSport registrations via Fuse Sport as well as student payments through OneStop.
9. Assist in the promotion of all student facing sport programs through actively engaging with students via social media and face to face at O week and other university promotion events.
10. Any other duties as requested by the La Trobe University Sport and the Snr Coord, Representative and High Performance Sport.
