## January 2025

This letter confirms the holiday periods for international students currently enrolled at La Trobe University.

International students on student visas undertaking a degree by coursework (Bachelor degree or Masters by coursework) are entitled to work 48 hours per fortnight when their course is in session, and unlimited hours when their course is on break.

#### In session means:

- Enrolment during advertised semesters/terms/non-standard study periods, including examination periods regardless of exam status (i.e., even if a student does not have any exams)
- Student is enrolled in any subject with credit points counting towards their course

A student undertaking a full research degree (Masters by research or PhD) may work unlimited hours during their studies in Australia.

For students studying packaged courses in La Trobe's <u>pathway program</u> (e.g. La Trobe College Australia [LTCA]'s Diploma course to La Trobe University's Bachelor program), their study is considered on break after they have formally completed their initial LTCA course and waiting for their Bachelor program to commence. They can work unlimited hours during this period.

# Notes:

- 1. Students can work unlimited hours when they are not studying in the above study periods. However, their work restrictions apply if they are enrolled in a simultaneous study period or any other study period not listed above (e.g. Term 1, Term 6, Winter Term, Summer Semester, non-standard study periods).
- 2. Semester-based courses are not in session during:
  - \* Semester 1 Mid-Semester break from 21 April to 25 April 2025
  - \*\*Semester 2 Mid-Semester break from 8 September to 12 September 2025



An international student can prove they are an enrolled student of La Trobe University by providing:

- an Academic Transcript, or;
- a Statement of Account for the Semester (internal versions from their StudentOnLine account), or;
- a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE), or;
- a La Trobe student card.
