Master of Nurse Practitioner E: npcoordination@latrobe.edu.au The Master of Nurse Practitioner program at La Trobe University prepares advanced practice nurses for endorsement as Nurse Practitioners by the Australian Health Practitioner Regulatory Agency (AHPRA).

It is a requirement of admission into the program that the student is supported through a collaborative arrangement with the university and their employing agency to complete 300 hours of work-based clinical placement to support professional development toward competency of the Nurse Practitioner Standards for Practice.

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Accreditation Council have prepared an explanatory note to help students and clinical placement providers understand clinical placement requirements in the context of nurse practitioner education. Please see the link below for further information.

The role of the nurse practitioner is an advanced practice role. It extends beyond the traditional scope of the registered nurse to include comprehensive health assessment, developing and initiating therapeutic plans of care, including prescribing pharmacological interventions, ordering and interpreting diagnostic tests and initiating and receiving referrals.

In Australia, nurse practitioners must meet regulatory and professional practice requirements by maintaining endorsement with AHPRA and adhering to the Nurse Practitioner Standards for Practice. The educational requirement for nurse practitioners in Australia is a Master's degree. La Trobe University's Master of Nurse Practitioner is an Australian Nursing and Midwifery Accreditation Council accredited course designed to prepare graduates for pathway 1 endorsement with AHPRA.

The student's clinical placement hours are attached to clinical internship subjects in the second year of study. They should be carried out with appropriate supervision in an environment that supports the student's professional development. Through online coursework, mentorship and clinical placement, students will develop expert judgement, evidence-based knowledge, and clinical competence in extended practice in their specialty area. La Trobe University will maintain regular contact with students throughout the clinical placement.

This document confirms support for the <u>applicant</u> from the clinical agency and the supervising team.

If the applicant successfully gains a place in the course, a formal agreement between the agency and the university must be completed to fulfil indemnity requirements and clinical governance.
