

Weed species- Albury Wodonga

Environmental weeds are non-native plants that can invade natural habitats, outcompeting native species and disrupting ecosystems. Monitoring these weeds is essential to protecting biodiversity by preventing their spread and ensuring they are effectively controlled or, in some cases, removed.
